



Reasons to be Cheerful


A Raucous Musical

It first toured in 2010, then in 2012, when it was a one-off gig at the London paralympics opening ceremony, and the

show was revived again in 2017, when this performance at London's Theatre Royal Stratford East was videoed.

Carousel


at Lincoln Center

Carousel is the second musical by the team of Richard Rodgers (music) and Oscar Hammerstein II (book and lyrics). The 1945 work was adapted from Ferenc Molnár's 1909 play *Liliom*, transplanting its Budapest setting to the Maine coastline. The story revolves around carousel barker Billy Bigelow, whose romance with millworker Julie Jordan comes at the price of both their jobs. He participates in a robbery to provide for Julie and their unborn child; after it goes tragically wrong, he is given a chance to make things right. A secondary plot line deals with millworker Carrie Pipperidge

and her romance with ambitious fisherman Enoch Snow. The show includes the well-known songs "If I Loved You", "June Is Bustin' Out All Over" and "You'll Never Walk Alone". Richard Rodgers later wrote that *Carousel* was his favorite of all his musicals.

1 hour 47 minutes duration


'Myth' is a British rock musical and a modern retelling of the ancient Greek story of Orpheus and the underworld. Filmed in 2018 on the West End.
