The Importance of Being Earnest by Oscar Wildedirected by David Goldman





When: Wednesday, August 19, 2020, starting at 3:00



The afternoon session will be comprised of various exercises to hone your listening skills, ability to react and use your creativity. Yes and, the emphasis is on having fun!
