This is one of the truest things... I have ever seen!

When I saw this meme... thoughts of great guys I have had the pleasure of knowing and playing with literally ripped through my mind.

Latest huge loss for me and many here at Lakeside was the great **Jimmy Barto**... this fine musician was a master entertainer and easily the most popular member of any band he was with... especially The Great American Songbook. Miss you Jimmy!

A super player too was **Jay Shuffle** (that was his stage name I found out after he passed... his last name was Syrop) who was a past master of the harmonica... Jay was so much more than most harmonica players and had perfect pitch. He was Mr. Dependabilty and the crowds loved him. One

funny thing with Jay was he actually use to think, "What band needs a harmonica player?"... Every band he ever played with and he played with some great ones... Miss you Jay!

I was 15 already playing for a few years and was walking up a street one day and heard someone playing a guitar being played rather well and different. I found this kid about 12 or 13 sitting on his back steps with an old Sears guitar (forget the brand) but sounding like a bass. I met the kid named **Les Vincent**. A couple of years later the bass player in the band I was playing with got thrown in reform school (now you know how long ago this was) and I thought of that kid and went to his house to ask him and as they say... the rest was history. Les went on to be probably one of the best bass players (a good singer too... use to do a lot of Ray Stevens' covers) in certainly Western Canada... Miss you Les!

The last one for right now I met when I was 16 and he was 13... he was quite a small guy and was in a bright red tuxedo playing with a great band... But there was **Jerry Ford** standing on a Japanese Orange box so that his baritone saxophone didn't hit the floor... he was okay with the tenor, soprano and flutes... and he was a great little showman. I started a band in 1964 to play 6 nights a week in my hometown in Canada and got Jerry into the band even though he wasn't 21 yet... because we played bars. Jerry wowed crowds every night for years... Miss you Jerry!






SUNDAY
