The legendary Lakeside singer and entertainer **Mac Morison** passed away peacefully in his sleep on March 27th... He was 88 years old.

Mac was an accomplished crooner with an incredibly beautiful baritone voice. He sang the jazz standards that many Lakeside residents fell in love to... and he sang them in the style of many greats such as Sinatra, Bennett, Torme and Damone.

In addition to doing many local shows, Mac did seven successful annual shows where he spotlighted local talent with whom he sang memorable duets. Proceeds from his shows always were given to local charities.

A celebration of Mac's life will be **April 24th at 4 PM at St Andrews Anglican Church** in Riberas.

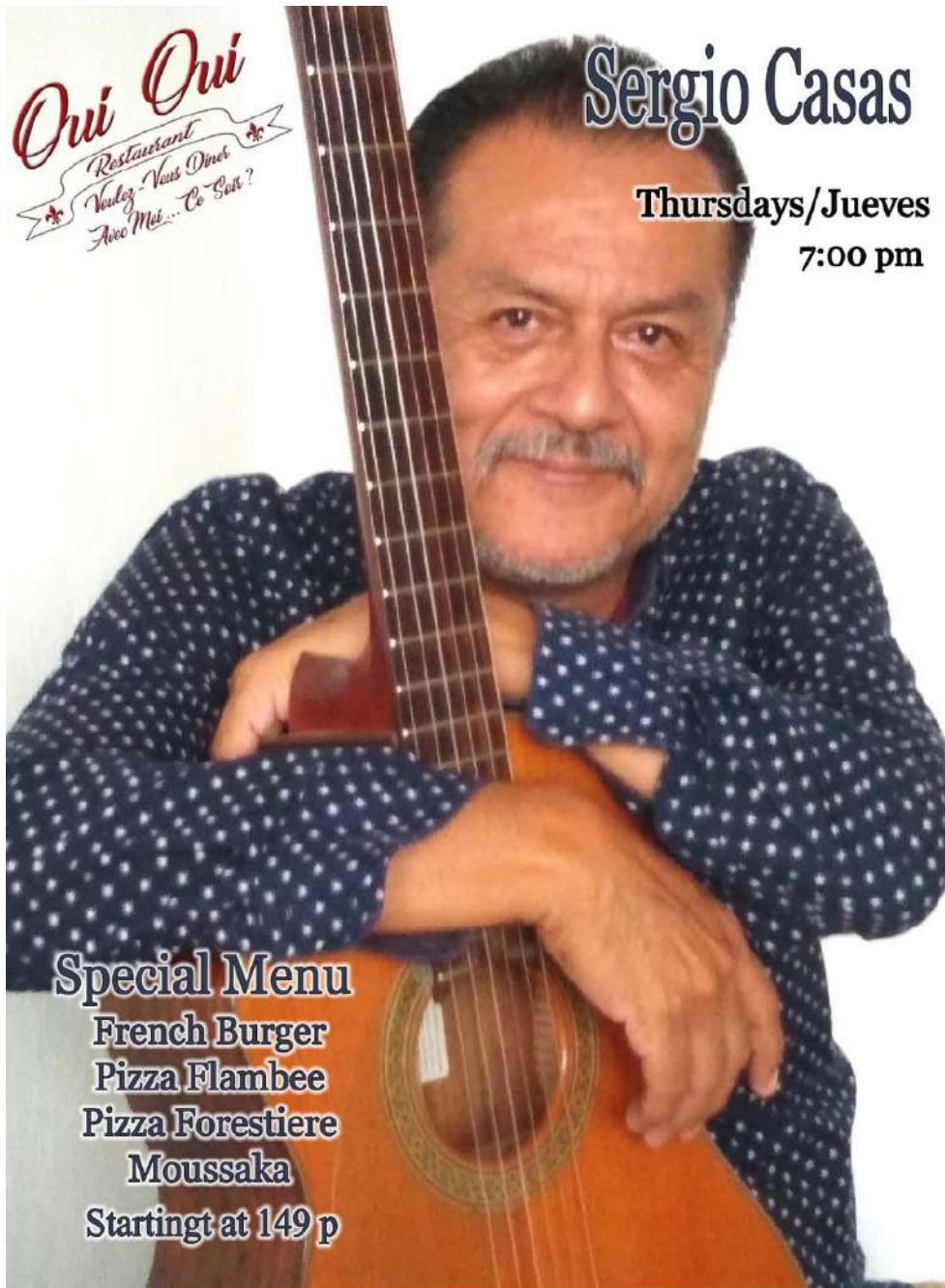

**The BRAVO! and Bare Stage Theatres present
Giving and Taking Direction: with Bernadette Jones**

This 8 week Zoom (at the time of this printing) workshop will deal with the relationship between director and actor. The participants (directors AND actors) will develop serviceable communication skills that will encourage co-operation and avoid confrontation on any project.

Throughout her professional career in theatre and film, Bernadette has been described as “an actor’s director”. Why? Because of her ability to COMMUNICATE her ideas for any given project effectively and to LISTEN to an actor when they wish to make a contribution.

These two key parties involved (director + actor), need to co-operate creatively for a project to develop into a satisfying production for both.

Also, because of Bernadette’s extensive experience teaching and coaching professional actors, she has evolved the ‘how to’ in

improving an actor's performance and in so doing, learned vocabulary that works to that end when directing.

All of this vast knowledge will be shared with the actors and directors taking this workshop. The use of short, two-person scenes from contemporary plays or films will be the vehicles in which both will learn to take direction or to give direction.

In the first 4 weeks (actor focused), Bernadette will be directing the actors in selected scenes. The directors participating will learn how co-operation works in the creative process and learn the vocabulary best to use when communicating with an actor. The directors will also be encouraged to ask questions or ask for more clarification on what they are watching.

In the second 4 weeks (director focused), the directors will be directing the actors participating in a second short, two-person scene of their choosing. Bernadette will then coach them if needed during the development of the actor's performances in their scenes.

When the theatres are open, all scenes will be showcased along with the work of the actors in the previous Monologue Workshop given by Bernadette.

Each class will be 2 1/2 hours / 1 day per week. (20 hours total).

Start date will be April 20 – June 8, 2021 (Tuesdays 11am – 1:30 pm)

This workshop will be limited to a maximum of 8 actors and 4 directors.

The fee for this exciting workshop is 4,000 pesos or register by April 10th and pay only 3,600 pesos. Register online via mymytickets@gmail.com or roswilshere@gmail.com. Payment will be arranged individually.
