We moved out to the "wild and wooly west" (Edmonton, Alberta) in 1950 just after my 8th birthday and soon after my Dad told me it was time to start music lessons... on accordion of course! I hated that damn thing and after spending time with an older boy down the street that was learning drums... I asked my Dad if I could take drums... he said, "Yes" and lined me up with a wonderful teacher, Lynn Wallace to take lessons... I loved it!

When I was about 12, I was doing pretty well and I got to play with my Dad's old time band and was paid like the other guys. Dad also put me in a pipe band to learn the rudiments... no pay but good learning.

Not long after some other kids in the neighborhood and I got together and formed a little dance band and a novelty "hillbilly" band (with more kids) and won a provincial talent contest.

Now at 78 I still play although my regular band, The Great American Songbook, hasn't played since March 14th of 2020. I have been invited to sit in here and there but really miss playing steady and hope to get back at it soon... we'll see what happens!

Music and playing has been a constant for most of my life and I miss it big time!


ABOUT THE PLAY:


To purchase at the Box Office:
