Background about the work "Inhabiting Michi-Cihualli" (Excerpts taken from an article written by Patrick O'Heffernan for Shutter16.com)

Michi-Cihualli is the Goddess of the Lake. She commands the wind and the waves and protects the Riberas, the lands around Lake Chapala. She is also a great reason for people to make music and dance and film and art.

The legend of the Goddess Michi-Cihualli has continued in paintings, murals, songs, and dances, and to this day, she animates the environmental organizations that fight pollution and overdevelopment of the Lake.

Paty Green, a talented young director from the University of Guadalajara, joined with the team at La Cochera to create an experimental film on Michi-Cihualli and a documentary on the making of the film. The Cochera staff built a three-day festival of music, dance, and art around the film's premiere in February, 2022. This is your chance to see that film and be entertained by the accompanying music and dance. The band for the live score (Emelia Galvéz, Eleazar "Chuco" Soto, Miguel Soto, and Juanpi Medeles) worked with the filmmaker to write the score and had recorded much of the music in advance.

The evening presents a live concert, performing the original music of the experimental short film "The Legend of Michi-Cihualli". The actress-dancer Mariajose Medeles, under the choreographic and creative direction of Leonor Zertuche, performs live in a contemporary dance montage to interpret the goddess Michi-Cihualli. Eleazar "Chuco" Soto (who is also a world-class saxophonist) provides his special magic. The director, Paty Green, takes elements from experimental video and re-uses them, re-editing them for a large screen and combines this theatric experience with live musicians and dance.
