The season line-up, including plays and dates, was announced in March and a minor change was made since then. Twelfth Night will replace Taming of the Shrew as our Shakespeare offering in November.

If you had a season ticket for Season 57, then you will soon be receiving an email asking if you want to renew the exact same seats for the same night for Season 58 and instructing you how you can pay for this online. You will also have a chance to change your seat or day, dependent on availability, prior to committing. Any desired changes should be requested by replying to this email or write to tickets@lakesidelittletheatre.com prior to coming to the box office to facilitate your purchase. The box office will be open on July 13 and 14 so that people can also renew in person. You can also decide not to renew -- but then you'd miss out on a great season!

In July emails will be sent to people who had season tickets in Season 55 but didn't renew, mainly due to COVID concerns. Reservations will be made for them closest to the seats they had in the 2019-2020 season. Again, they can simply renew by finalizing the purchase, opt to change seat or day by replying to this email or write to tickets@lakesidelittletheatre.com , or alternatively decide not to renew. The box office will be open again on July 27 and 28 to execute purchases.

After renewals have been processed, an announcement will go out to the general email list in early August allowing people to purchase season tickets online or come to the box office on two dates in August, to be announced closer to the dates.


#### **SEASON & PRICING:**


