





"Bluegrass & Beyond" w/ Jeffree White & Jan Reimers





César Reyes Piano

Mexican-American Planist and Musicologist César Reyes is one of the leading performers of Latin American Music in the United States. An active member of the Society for American Music, he has presented lecture-recitals on the piano music of Mexico in the most prestigious conferences of the United States and Europe, including the American Musicological Society (AMS), the Society for American Music (SAM) and Yale University. He has also appeared in Carnegie Hall, Symphony Space, Trinity Church and Palacio de Bellas Artes in Mexico. After graduating from Mexico's National Conservatory, he came to the United States in 2001 to continue his studies under the direction of the renowned Cuban-American pedagogue Germán Diez, disciple and assistant of the legendary planist Claudio Arrau. Mr. Reyes earned a Masters Degree in Music and a Master in Arts at the City University of New York with the support of the Mexican Government, He is the Founder and Artistic Director of the Latin American Piano and Song Festival of New York, the first festival in the United States dedicated to the exploration of classical, folk, and popular traditions of the Latin American plano and song repertoire. He is a winner of a grant 2020-2023 from "Sistema de Apoyos a la Creacion y Proyectos Culturales (SACPC)* to perform Mexican and Latin American Music.






