I got to know Floyd in the early '60's when the band I was in regularly went from Edmonton to Calgary to play. My band was called Don McKenzie and the Knights and like a few bands from Edmonton... had horns!

We played at the Gardens (a huge dance hall on 17th Ave. S.W.) on Friday nights and for a dance show on CFCN TV on Saturday afternoons and drove back north on Sunday.

Floyd and I are the same age and he use to sit in for a few numbers when we played there... you could tell he would do well in the music business and it wasn't long until that came to be as he went with Three Dog Night... he was a super nice guy and was known as such throughout his career.

It was the horns in The Knights that drew Floyd and many others in Calgary... Edmonton had a large number of very good horn players no doubt because of the Edmonton School Boys Band which was a huge marching band that ran for years in that city. Many well known "horn bands" came to Edmonton back then and over the years... but they are gone now!

Farewell Floyd and Rest in Peace my friend.
