What do you think happened that you don't see that anymore? In the mid '70's things started to change... people (I won't call them musicians) came along playing for "a couple of beers and tips", DJ's, karaoke, jam sessions, etc.

Most of the big clubs that used to be full 6 nights a week not only eventually closed but went bankrupt... buildings were torn down... the music "died".

In that 20 years we had one disasterous couple of days... it dropped down to -40 farenheit (or celsius) but they were back out in a few days... those were the days!
