Susan Sontag spent the majority of her adult life <u>reading</u> between eight and ten hours a day, and never fewer than four. Her intense love of literature was paralleled by a commensurate love of music. In a diary entry found in *Reborn: Journals and Notebooks, 1947–1963* (*public library*) — the spectacular volume that gave us young Sontag on <u>personal growth</u>, <u>art</u>, <u>marriage</u>, <u>the four people a great writer must be</u>, and her <u>duties for being a twenty-something</u> — she writes at age 15:

Music is at once the most wonderful, the most alive of all the arts — it is the most abstract, the most perfect, the most pure — and the most sensual. I listen with my body and it is my body that aches in response to the passion and pathos embodied in this music.




Jeffree may or may not sing, depending on the vibe of the scene.
















Billy Blackwood
