



Shriners' dual Ribfests support care for disabled kids

The Lake Chapala Shrine Club has an outstanding record for helping children in the Lakeside area who suffer from physical disabilities.

Among its endeavors, the organization pays for transportation for families traveling to the Shriners Hospital in Mexico City, arranges local and Guadalajara-based therapy sessions and provides orthopedic equipment for young patients.

These essential services are primarily funded by proceeds from the club's annual Ribfest.

This year, the popular event is expanding to a two-day format, running back-to-back on Tuesday, March 4, and Wednesday, March 5, from 1 to 5 P.M. each day.

The event will once again feature sumptuous grilled rib platters, catered and served at the table by Adelita Bar & Grill. The venue is Villa Encantada, located at Avenida Hidalgo 312, next to Parque La Milagrosa on Chapala's western outskirts. Ample parking is available near Hotel Montecarlo, where guests can take advantage of a free shuttle service to the event.
